

Pizza Sweater

Looking for a way to keep your pizza warm in transit?
Eager to make sure your pizza knows it is loved?
Look no further than this pizza sweater: a snug cozy for a pizza box.



Specifications

Finished Dimensions: 11.75" x 15.5"

Designed to fit snugly on a medium pizza box from Domino's. If your beloved pizza purveyor has a larger box of this shape, just continue the increase rounds until your sweater reaches the desired circumference.

Materials:

Worsted weight yarn, 110 grams (4 oz), approximately 185 meters (200 yards)

Size 8 circular needles (or size needed to obtain gauge)

Stitch Marker

Gauge: 4 stitches per inch, 6 rows per inch

Notes

Abbreviations

K = Knit

P = Purl

M1r = Make 1 Stitch right

M1l = Make 1 Stitch left

(For help with M1r and M1l, I recommend [this instructional video](#))

Note: Judy's Magic Cast-On is typically used for toe-up socks, and I've chosen it for this pattern because it creates a seamless final product. If you've never used this cast-on (or you just want a refresher), I recommend this instructional [video](#) from VeryPink Knits.

Increase Round Pattern

Side 1: K1, M1r, K to last 2 stitches on *that side*, M1l, K1

Side 2: K1, M1r, K to last 2 stitches on *that side*, M1l, K1

Pattern

Getting Started

Use [Judy's Magic Cast-On](#) to cast on 66 stitches (33 on each needle). Your last cast-on stitch should be on the bottom needle using the yarn tail.

Round 1, Side 1: Rotate your work so the points of the needles face to the right, and 'lock' your yarn tail under the working yarn (as demonstrated in the video linked above). Pull out the bottom needle so those stitches rest on the cable, place marker, and knit across.

Round 1, Side 2: Rotate your work, pull out the bottom needle so those stitches rest on the cable. Knit 1 (this is the slipknot) and then knit across *through the back loop* (as demonstrated in the video linked above).

Round 2: Knit

Increase Rounds



- Round 4: Increase round (70 stitches, 35 each side)
- Round 5: Knit
- Round 6: Increase round (74 stitches, 37 each side)
- Round 7: Knit
- Round 8: Knit
- Round 9: Increase round (78 stitches, 39 each side)
- Round 10: Knit
- Round 11: Knit
- Round 12: Knit
- Round 13: Increase round (82 stitches, 41 each side)
- Round 14: Knit
- Round 15: Knit
- Round 16: Knit
- Round 17: Knit
- Round 18: Increase round (86 stitches, 43 each side)
- Round 19: Knit
- Round 20: Knit
- Round 21: Knit
- Round 22: Knit
- Round 23: Knit
- Round 24: Increase round (90 stitches, 45 each side)

Main Body

Knit in the round until piece measures 14 inches from cast on to cable.



Ribbed Finish

Work 7 rounds of K3, P3 ribbing.

Cast off loosely in ribbing pattern. Weave in ends.
